Basic goals, fundamental concepts, simple tactics and techniques are the focus. **Prerequisite: Students must know how to play.** 

<u>Adv Beginner Class</u> - 6 Sundays: Sept 10 - Oct 15 Time: 2 - 3 pm Cost - \$45 Recommended playing level 350-600 or permission of instructor

Solving short problems, improving endgame skills, discussion of strategic principles, and an introduction to commonly played openings along with the ideas behind them are the main topics in this class. Open to kids & adults.
